Bell Peppers-

Cooler, winter like temps through Florida have slowed growth on bells. Additionally, Georgia will be entirely finished by the weekend, placing increased demand on Florida product. Market will climb through December.

Cucumbers –

Cucumbers will become an increasingly tight commodity in the coming weeks. Domestic Florida crops are winding down in the next 10-14 days and then we head into a gap between Florida and Honduran product. What Honduran product trickles in at the end of the month will historically be very expensive.

Eggplant –

Eggplants finished in Georgia and is now entirely Florida product. There seems to be a lot around, including Nogales ramped up in eggs. Quality is excellent and markets will be cheap in Florida for the remainder of the month.

Squash-

With the full moon and Nogales being very cheap on squash, the Florida market is dropping rapidly. It should stay at the lower levels for the next week or two. Going forward, Florida will follow in line with Nogales squash prices.

Corn-

Corn market is on the move as cooler Florida temperatures take their toll. Shippers will try to keep this market elevated as more business moves into the corn heavy region of south Florida.
